- 3 last surviving daughter of a Confederate soldier; and
- 4 WHEREAS, she is the daughter of Corporal Lewis Gay who fought in the Battle of Dallas

- 6 WHEREAS, Corporal Lewis Gay was awarded the Southern Cross of Honor for his service

- 8 WHEREAS, Corporal Gay lived from July 7, 1840, until October 16, 1931, at which point
- 9 he was buried at Old Providence Cemetery in Union County, Florida; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Mrs. Jordan was born to Corporal Gay on October 20, 1922, in Union County,
- 11 Florida; and
- WHEREAS, she has a wealth of knowledge that she has received from her father's stories
- 13 about life in the Confederate Army; and
- 14 WHEREAS, this knowledge makes Mrs. Jordan an invaluable link to our nation's history;

- 16 WHEREAS, she has been a continual member of the United Daughters of the Confederacy
- 17 for 50 years; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Mrs. Jordan is regarded in the highest esteem by all who meet her, making it
- 19 fitting and proper that the accomplishments of this distinguished Georgian be appropriately
- 20 recognized.
