- 1 Recognizing United States military veterans and dedicating an interchange in their honor;
- 2 and for other purposes.

- 12 WHEREAS, it is important that veterans are thanked for their selfless service to this nation
- and honored for their unyielding commitment to protecting the people and ideals of the

- 15 WHEREAS, veterans embody the spirit of service, willing to find meaning in something
- 16 greater than themselves, and it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding
- 17 accomplishments and sacrifices of these remarkable and distinguished Americans be honored
- 18 appropriately.
- 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
- 20 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that this body hereby joins in honoring United States military
- veterans and dedicates the interchange at Interstate 20 and Exit 78/Sigman Road in Rockdale
- 22 County as the Walk of Heroes/Veterans Interchange.
