A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Patrick D. Doyle; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia recently lost one of its finest citizens and most dedicated
3 law enforcement officers with the untimely passing of Patrick D. Doyle; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Patrick D. Doyle was born on November 20, 1971, and will be sorely missed
5 by his loving wife, Dacia, and their beloved son, PJ; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Patrick D. Doyle served with honor and distinction on the Lookout Mountain
7 Judicial Circuit Drug Task Force starting in 2003 and became the task force commander in
8 2012; and
- 9 WHEREAS, he was an honest and dedicated public servant whose primary concern was the
10 welfare and safety of the citizens of Georgia; and
- 11 WHEREAS, he was highly regarded by the citizens of his community and by state and local
12 government officials as a man of unquestioned integrity and dedication to the administration
13 of justice and sound principles of law enforcement; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Commander Doyle exhibited extraordinary devotion to duty, outstanding
15 loyalty, fine leadership, and meticulous attention to detail in all of his duties; and
- 16 WHEREAS, he will long be remembered for his inspiring commitment to the welfare of
17 others, which stands as a shining example of the positive effect law enforcement
18 professionals have on the lives and well-being of others.
- 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
20 join in honoring the life and memory of Patrick D. Doyle and express their most sincere
21 condolences at his passing.
