A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the importance of the proper positioning and manner of display of the American
2 flag as well as the uniforms of members of the United States military in television and
3 movies; and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, Georgia is now ranked 3rd in the nation in film production; and

5 WHEREAS, Chapter 7 of Section 1 of Title 4 of the United States Code describes in detail
6 the proper positioning and manner of display for the flag of the United States of America;
7 and

8 WHEREAS, the United States Army, in AR 670-1, describes in detail the proper uniform
9 regulations for all members of service; and

10 WHEREAS, the United States Navy, in NAVPERS 15665I, describes in detail the proper
11 uniform regulations for all members of service; and

12 WHEREAS, the United States Marine Corps, in MCO P1020.34G, describes in detail the
13 proper uniform regulations for all members of service; and

14 WHEREAS, the United States Air Force, in AFI 36-2903, describes in detail the proper
15 uniform regulations for all members of service; and

16 WHEREAS, the United States Coast Guard, in COMDTINST M 1020.6H, describes in detail
17 the proper uniform regulations for all members of service.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
19 recognize the importance of the proper positioning and manner of display of the American
20 flag as well as the uniforms of members of the United States military in television and
21 movies that should be addressed by the film industry as well as local and state agencies.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
23 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the public and the
24 press.
