A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing March 12, 2020, as Sex Trafficking Awareness Day at the state capitol; and for
- 2 other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, sex trafficking is a form of modern day slavery where people profit from the
- 4 control and exploitation of others and is a horrific crime perpetrated against women and
- 5 children; and
- 6 WHEREAS, sex trafficking is one of the fastest growing criminal enterprises in the world,
- 7 and according to the International Labour Organization, profits obtained from commercial
- 8 sexual exploitation are estimated at \$99 billion per year globally; and
- 9 WHEREAS, according to a 2014 study by the Urban Institute, the underground sex industry
- 10 in Atlanta grew from \$238 million to \$290 million from 2003 to 2007, which was a 22
- 11 percent increase; and
- 12 WHEREAS, hundreds of grassroots activists will gather at the state capitol on March 12,
- 13 2020, to raise awareness about the need to end sex trafficking in Georgia; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Georgia Cares, House of Cherith, Out of Darkness, and Street Grace have
- 15 worked together to organize and empower tens of thousands of grassroots activists across the
- 16 State of Georgia to end sex trafficking.
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 18 recognize March 12, 2020, as Sex Trafficking Awareness Day at the state capitol.
- 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 20 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to Georgia Cares,
- 21 House of Cherith, Out of Darkness, and Street Grace.
