A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing March 25, 2020, as National Guard Day at the state capitol; and for other
- 2 purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Defense provides ready and relevant military forces
- 4 to Combatant Commanders to fight our nation's enemies and provides disaster response in
- 5 support of homeland defense and defense support to civil authorities; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Defense is headquartered at the Clay National Guard
- 7 Center in Marietta, Georgia, and consists of 11, 200 Army National Guard soldiers, 2,800
- 8 Air National Guard airmen, 500 State Defense Force volunteers, and 600 state employees;
- 9 and
- 10 WHEREAS, Georgia's Army National Guard is organized into five major subordinate
- 11 commands, which are the Macon based 48th Infantry Brigade Combat Team, the 648th
- 12 Maneuver Enhancement Brigade at Fort Benning, and the 78th Aviation Troop Command,
- 13 201st Regional Support Group, and 78th Troop Command at the Clay National Guard Center
- 14 in Marietta; and
- 15 WHEREAS, the Georgia Air National Guard serves as the air power component of the State
- of Georgia with airmen assigned to the 116th Air Control Wing in Warner Robins, the 165th
- 17 Airlift Wing in Savannah, and geographically separated units throughout Georgia, including
- 18 Savannah's Air Dominance Center, the nation's premier fighter integration training center;

- 20 WHEREAS, the Georgia State Defense Force is a volunteer unit of the Georgia Department
- 21 of Defense, serving under direction of the Governor and the Adjutant General of Georgia to
- 22 provide emergency and disaster response; and

23 WHEREAS, the Georgia National Guard celebrated the 25th anniversary of its state

- 24 partnership with the Country of Georgia in 2019 and continues to broaden its partnership
- 25 with the Republic of Argentina; and
- 26 WHEREAS, the Georgia National Guard operates one of the most successful Youth
- 27 Challenge Academy programs in the United States at campuses at Fort Stewart, Fort Gordon,
- and Milledgeville, where more than 17,200 at-risk youth have completed a rigorous 22-week
- 29 program in pursuit of their high school or general educational development diploma; and
- 30 WHEREAS, in 2019, the Georgia National Guard mobilized soldiers and airmen to
- 31 Combatant Commands on five continents in support of combat operations and multi-national
- 32 exercises while providing personnel and expertise as part of state and regional responses to
- 33 emergencies, notably, Hurricane Dorian; and
- 34 WHEREAS, from the earliest muster of Georgia's colonial militia in 1733 to the present day,
- 35 Georgia's citizens have volunteered to defend our state and nation in the Georgia National
- 36 Guard, balancing civilian and family interests with a cause greater than themselves, it is
- 37 abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of these remarkable and
- 38 distinguished Georgians be appropriately recognized.
- 39 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 40 commend the men and women of the Georgia National Guard for their resolve and enduring
- 41 sacrifices on behalf of a grateful state and nation and do hereby recognize March 25, 2020,
- 42 as National Guard Day at the state capitol.
- 43 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 44 to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to the Georgia
- 45 National Guard.
