A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life and memory of Mr. Charles R. Lusk and dedicating an intersection in his
2 memory; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia lost one of its finest citizens with the passing of
4 Mr. Charles R. Lusk; and

5 WHEREAS, a graduate of Rossville High School in Walker County, Mr. Lusk diligently and
6 conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time, talents, and energy toward the
7 betterment of his community and state; and

8 WHEREAS, he served with honor and distinction as president and CEO of both
9 Fort Oglethorpe State Bank and Rossville Bank; and

10 WHEREAS, his leadership and organizational talents were recognized with numerous
11 awards and accolades, including a Lifetime Service Award from the Community Bankers
12 Association of Georgia and Outstanding Chamber Member Award from the Walker County
13 Chamber of Commerce; and

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Lusk was an active board member of the Community Bankers Association
15 of Georgia, Independent Bankers Association of America, Walker and Catoosa County
16 Chamber of Commerce, and Greater Chattanooga Christian Services and Children's Home;

18 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
19 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating an intersection in his memory.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
21 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the intersection at Chickamauga Avenue and Spring Street
22 in Walker County is dedicated as the Charles R. Lusk Memorial Intersection.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
24 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Charles R. Lusk Memorial
25 Intersection.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
27 to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to the family of
28 Mr. Charles R. Lusk.
