A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Taos Wynn and Perfect Love Foundation and recognizing
2 March 8, 2018, as Unify Georgia Day at the state capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, in divisive times of inequality and social and political polarization, it is
4 important to recognize the spirit of brotherhood and the power of humanity that have ushered
5 our state away from the darkest hours of its discriminatory past; and

6 WHEREAS, the resounding echo of equality is present in the framework of our invariable
7 Constitution, and thus it is right to promote a societal unity that transcends gender, color, and
8 lifestyle by celebrating how far society has come, and it is also right to honor those
9 individuals who paid progress' cost by rising above provocative diatribes and temptations of
10 moral regression; and

11 WHEREAS, the fortitude of solidarity is stronger than the propaganda of widespread hate
12 and the most powerful and enduring weapon against division's provenance is love; and

13 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper to call for excellence in every sector across
14 the state; to call for love to reverberate throughout the State of Georgia, dispelling
15 discrimination, embracing differences, ending injustices, respecting individual liberties, and
16 encouraging the progression of unity.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
18 commemorate Georgia's social progress, its opposition to discrimination, and its mandate for
19 unity and love and recognize March 8, 2018, as Unify Georgia Day at the state capitol.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
21 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to Taos Wynn, Perfect
22 Love Foundation, the public, and the press.
