A RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution so as to provide that persons convicted of
- 2 felonies shall lose their right to vote only if they are sentenced to incarceration and only
- 3 while serving any such sentence of incarceration; to provide for related matters; to provide
- 4 for the submission of this amendment for ratification or rejection; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article II, Section I of the Constitution is amended by revising Paragraph III(a) as follows:
- 8 "(a) No person who has been convicted of a felony involving moral turpitude and
- 9 <u>sentenced to serve a period of incarceration</u> may register, remain registered, or vote except
- 10 upon completion of the sentence of incarceration. No disqualification from voting shall be
- imposed while serving a period of parole or probation or for any outstanding fines or fees."

12 SECTION 2.

- 13 The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as
- provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the
- above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:
- 16 "() YES Shall the Constitution of Georgia be amended so as to provide that persons
- 17 () NO convicted of felonies shall lose their right to vote only if they are sentenced
- to incarceration and only while serving any such sentence of incarceration?"
- 19 All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."
- 20 All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If
- 21 such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall
- become a part of the Constitution of this state.
