A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the University of Georgia School of Law on its National Moot
2 Court Championship; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the University of Georgia School of Law was represented at the 70th Annual
4 National Moot Court Competition by third-year law students Jonathan Kaufman, John Lex
5 Kenerly IV, and Joseph H. "Joe" Stuhrenberg; and

6 WHEREAS, the trio was undefeated in the national tier of the tournament held in New York
7 City, New York, and Mr. Stuhrenberg was named the competition's best oralist; and

8 WHEREAS, during the competition, the trio had victories over Georgetown University,
9 Loyola University Chicago, Drake University, and Saint Louis University; and

10 WHEREAS, the National Moot Court Competition is the oldest and one of the most
11 prestigious moot court competitions in the country; and

12 WHEREAS, teams from more than 120 law schools across the nation competed in this year's
13 contest; and

14 WHEREAS, this is the fourth time that the University of Georgia School of Law has won
15 this championship; and

16 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this national championship by the
17 University of Georgia School of Law Moot Court team be celebrated.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
19 recognize and commend the University of Georgia School of Law Moot Court team and the
20 law school's Director of Advocacy, Kellie Casey, for their achievement and
21 accomplishments.
