ADOPTED SENATE

A RESOLUTION

- 1 Creating the Senate Child Protection Study Committee; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, ensuring the safety and welfare of Georgia's children is one of the most
- 3 important functions of the State of Georgia; and
- 4 WHEREAS, statistics indicate that children entering foster care are at an increased risk of
- 5 developmental delays and disabilities due to a variety of factors; and
- 6 WHEREAS, more than 152 children under the care of the Division of Family and Children
- 7 Services of the Department of Human Resources have died in recent years; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the deaths of Eric Forbes and Emani Moss occurred in part because of
- 9 deficiencies in the Child Protective Services Division of the Department of Human
- 10 Resources; and
- WHEREAS, it is vital that our state child support services are capable of quickly identifying
- 12 and assessing situations which pose a danger to children and of developing and implementing
- 13 plans of family assistance and intervention in order to protect the lives and future of our
- 14 children and prevent future tragedies; and
- 15 WHEREAS, of critical importance is improving outcomes for children and families, thus
- 16 ensuring appropriate child placement and providing a sense of security, permanence, and
- 17 stability for children in our care; and
- 18 WHEREAS, the state should give priority to reducing the number of moves and placements
- 19 of children in out-of-home care, increasing family foster care resources, and decreasing the
- 20 length of time children are separated from their homes through the provision of quality
- 21 supportive services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that there is created the Senate

- 23 Child Protection Study Committee to be composed of six members of the Senate appointed
- 24 by the President of the Senate. The President of the Senate shall designate one of the
- 25 appointees to serve as chairperson of the committee. The chairperson shall call all meetings
- of the committee.
- 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee shall undertake a study of the conditions,
- 28 needs, issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any actions
- 29 or legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate. The committee may
- 30 conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as it may deem necessary or
- 31 convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform its duties, and
- 32 accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution. The members of the committee
- 33 shall receive the allowances authorized for legislative members of interim legislative
- 34 committees but shall receive the same for not more than three days unless an additional two
- 35 days are authorized by the President of the Senate. The funds necessary to carry out the
- 36 provisions of this resolution shall come from the funds appropriated to the Senate. In the
- 37 event that the committee makes a report of its findings and recommendations for proposed
- 38 legislation, such report shall be made no later than December 1, 2014. The committee shall
- 39 stand abolished on December 1, 2014.
