- 14 demonstrated to her family and friends were admired by others; and
- 15 WHEREAS, she was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
- 16 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example she made of her life,
- 17 she made this world a better place in which to live; and
- 18 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous woman, Judge Ingram will long be remembered
- 19 for her love of family, friendship, and community and will be missed by all who had the
- 20 great fortune of knowing her.
