- 14 WHEREAS, Olivia has presented her own written bill to increase funding for childhood
- 15 cancer drugs at the Junior Youth Assembly meeting in Atlanta, in order to help other young
- 16 individuals fight childhood cancer; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Olivia continues to raise awareness for childhood cancer by participating in
- 18 Bartow County's Relay for Life to continue to spread hope that cancer can be overcome; and
- 19 WHEREAS, less than a year ago, she completed her chemotherapy and received a bone
