## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Senator Steve Henson for his outstanding public service; and
- 2 for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, after a lifelong commitment to the betterment of Georgia, Senator Steve Henson
- 4 is retiring at the end of session from the Georgia State Senate; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Senator Henson has lived, worked, and served his constituents in the great State
- 6 of Georgia for most of his life; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Senator Henson attended DeKalb County public schools and went on to earn
- 8 a degree in economics from the University of Georgia; and
- 9 WHEREAS, his early experiences prompted a lifelong interest in education and his tireless
- 10 work to expand access to public and higher education for all Georgians; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Senator Henson has been actively engaged in politics since an early age and
- served as the president of the Young Democrats of Georgia; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Senator Henson has been repeatedly recognized for his altruism and passion for
- 14 public service, even since before entering elected office, earning him the title of an
- 15 "Outstanding Young Man of America" in 1984 and "Volunteer of the Year" in 1988 by the
- 16 DeKalb County Democratic Party, where he is a member of the party's executive committee;

- 18 WHEREAS, Senator Henson has dedicated his time to numerous community organizations,
- 19 including YouthBuild, Tucker Jaycees, Stone Mountain Exchange, DeKalb County Lung
- 20 Association, League of Women Voters, PRISM, Georgia Advisory Council for the Mentally
- 21 Ill, and the Georgia Epilepsy Board; and

WHEREAS, in 1990, the people of DeKalb County first elected Senator Henson to the

- 23 Senate, where he led that body on issues of environmental protection, education, ethics, and
- 24 Georgia's economy until leaving the Senate in 1998; and
- 25 WHEREAS, Senator Henson served as one of Governor Zell Miller's floor leaders, helping
- 26 pass the Governor's key legislative accomplishments, including the HOPE Scholarship,
- 27 which has helped millions of Georgians attend college; and
- 28 WHEREAS, Senator Henson's vigorous devotion to and forward thinking on environmental
- 29 protection led Georgia to protect its wetlands and now provides all Georgians with cleaner
- 30 air and water; and
- 31 WHEREAS, Senator Henson has been committed to ensuring that women have the right to
- 32 choose health care that is appropriate to them and to live free from any violence; he authored
- 33 the Governor's Task Force on Teenage Pregnancy; and
- 34 WHEREAS, Senator Henson has worked to ensure that all Georgians have the right to live
- 35 without fear and with full rights guaranteed by the Constitution; and
- 36 WHEREAS, Senator Henson has been a staunch defender of access to the ballot box and the
- 37 right to vote; and
- 38 WHEREAS, Senator Henson was re-elected to the Georgia Senate in 2003, where he
- 39 continued to honorably advocate for his values and to reach across the aisle in a bipartisan
- 40 manner to solve Georgia's most pressing issues; and
- 41 WHEREAS, Senator Henson introduced and helped pass legislation supporting DeKalb
- 42 County community development, economic opportunity, infrastructure improvements, and
- a more robust tax base; and
- 44 WHEREAS, Senator Henson provides invaluable insight and leadership as vice chairman of
- 45 the Urban Affairs Committee and as a member of the Ethics, Health and Human Services,
- 46 Reapportionment and Redistricting, Regulated Industries and Utilities, Rules, and State

- 48 WHEREAS, during his tenure Senator Henson has received the endorsement and support of
- 49 many trusted community leaders and organizations, including Congressman Hank Johnson,

- 54 citizens by opposing budget cuts to Georgia's vital social services and educational programs;

- 56 WHEREAS, Senator Henson has provided the Georgia Senate Democratic Caucus with
- 57 invaluable leadership for four decades and has acted as one of Georgia's leading voices on
- 58 health care, education, and Georgia's economy; and
- 59 WHEREAS, Senator Henson has served the Georgia Senate and the people of Georgia with
- 60 honor and distinction, and his effective leadership and devotion to public service will be
- 61 sorely missed upon his retirement; and
- 62 WHEREAS, Senator Henson will continue his diligent and effective work advocating for the
- 63 rights and dignity of laborers by continuing as regional training director with the Labor's
- 64 Local 515.
