- 18 organization of the restoration of the Wilson Brannen Cemetery; and
- 19 WHEREAS, he did much of the preparatory work required before the cemetery was able to
- 20 be restored, including killing large plants and weeds with chemicals; assessing necessary
- 21 tools and machinery; locating and gathering necessary tools, machines, and food for the
