STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

This is the enhancement appropriation bill for the Commission on the Arts. As detailed in Table 1 of the fiscal note, it appropriates an additional \$18,400 from the General Fund. This increase is to provide a state match to federal National Endowment for the Arts (NEA) grant funding in order to provide four additional Arts in Education Grants in Idaho Communities.

FISCAL NOTE

This appropriation provides an additional \$18,400 from the General Fund to the maintenance appropriation provided to General Government agencies found in Senate Bill 1110. Table 1 shows the incremental adjustments to the budget found in the bill, of which the ongoing increase is \$18,400. Table 2 shows all the adjustments leading to the FY 2026 Total. The total budget for the Commission on the Arts is \$2,335,100.
