HOUSE BILL NO. 39

BY TRANSPORTATION AND DEFENSE COMMITTEE

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO RECREATIONAL VEHICLES; AMENDING SECTION 49-445, IDAHO CODE, TO
2 PROVIDE THAT INITIAL LICENSE FEES FOR RECREATIONAL VEHICLES SHALL BE
3 PRORATED ON A MONTHLY BASIS FOR NEW OWNERS AND SUBSEQUENT RENEWALS OF
4 ANNUAL LICENSES SHALL REQUIRE ANNUAL FEES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 SECTION 1. That Section 49-445, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
8 amended to read as follows:

9 49-445. RECREATIONAL VEHICLE ANNUAL LICENSE. (1) There is levied and
10 there shall be collected an annual license fee on each recreational vehicle
11 in Idaho, except recreational vehicles in possession of a manufacturer or
12 dealer and offered for sale or resale. If the recreational vehicle is reg-
13 istered as a motor vehicle under the provisions of this chapter, the annual
14 license fee imposed in this section shall be in addition to and not in lieu of
15 the motor vehicle registration fees. Initial license fees for recreational
16 vehicles shall be prorated on a monthly basis for a new owner. Subsequent re-
17 newals of the annual license shall require annual fees regardless of the reg-
18 istration date.

19 (2) The annual license fee imposed upon each recreational vehicle shall
20 be eight dollars and fifty cents (\$8.50) for a market value of one thousand
21 dollars (\$1,000) or less, and an additional five dollars (\$5.00) for each ad-
22 ditional one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or portion of it, of market value.

23 (3) Payment of the annual license fee shall license the recreational
24 vehicle for a calendar year, irrespective of the month in which it is regis-
25 tered, change of ownership of the vehicle, or change of county of residence
26 of the owner. The recreational vehicle annual license shall expire midnight
27 December 31 of each year.

28 (4) The license sticker shall be placed on the rear of the recreational
29 vehicle in a manner that is completely visible and shall be kept in a legible
30 condition at all times.

31 SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
32 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its
33 passage and approval.
