AN ACT

- RELATING TO REGISTRATION OF ELECTORS; PROVIDING A SHORT TITLE; AMENDING SEC TION 34-404, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE FOR REGISTRATION OF ELIGIBLE ELEC TORS AT DRIVER'S LICENSING OFFICES, TO PROVIDE THAT THE DIVISION OF MO TOR VEHICLES SHALL FORWARD REGISTRATION APPLICATIONS TO THE OFFICE OF
 THE COUNTY CLERK, AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS; AND DECLARING AN
 EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

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9 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. This act shall be known and may be cited as the 10 "Motor Voter Act."

SECTION 2. That Section 34-404, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

34-404. REGISTRATION OF ELECTORS. (1) All electors must register be-13 14 fore being able to vote at any primary, general, special, school or any other election governed by the provisions of title 34, Idaho Code. Registration of 15 a qualified person occurs when a legible, accurate and complete registration 16 application is received in the office of the county clerk or is received at 17 the polls pursuant to section 34-408A, Idaho Code, or when an electronic reg-18 istration application is received by the county clerk from the Idaho trans-19 portation department through the division of motor vehicles as provided for 20 in subsection (2) of this section. 21

(2) The Idaho transportation department, through the division of motor 22 vehicles and its driver's licensing offices, shall register to vote each el-23 igible elector who applies for the issuance, renewal, or correction of any 24 type of driver's license pursuant to chapter 3, title 49, Idaho Code, or for 25 an identification card pursuant to sections 49-2442 and 49-2443, Idaho Code, 26 by completing a registration application provided for in subsection (1) of 27 this section for the eligible elector through the division of motor vehi-28 29 cles. Each driver's licensing office shall forward completed registration applications to the office of the county clerk on a weekly basis and on the 30 business day prior to the closing of registration. Registration applica-31 tions remitted during closure of registration shall be held pursuant to sec-32 33 tion 34-408, Idaho Code. The division of motor vehicles shall provide for an elector to opt out of registration provided for in this section. 34

35 (3) Each elector may select on the registration application an affili-36 ation with a political party qualified to participate in elections pursuant 37 to section 34-501, Idaho Code, or may select to be designated as "unaffili-38 ated." The county clerk shall record the party affiliation or "unaffiliated" 39 designation so selected as part of the elector's registration record. If an 40 elector shall fail or refuse to make such a selection, the county clerk shall 41 enter on the registration records that such elector is "unaffiliated."

(34) In order to provide an elector with the appropriate primary elec-1 tion ballot, pursuant to section 34-904A, Idaho Code, the poll book for 2 primary elections shall include the party affiliation or designation as 3 "unaffiliated" for each elector so registered. An "unaffiliated" elector 4 shall declare to the poll worker which primary election ballot the elec-5 tor chooses to vote in, pursuant to section 34-904A, Idaho Code, and the 6 7 poll worker or other authorized election personnel shall record such declaration in the poll book. The poll book shall contain checkoff boxes to 8 allow the poll worker or other authorized election personnel to record such 9 "unaffiliated" elector's selection. 10

11 (45) In order to provide electors who are already registered to vote, and who remain registered electors, with an opportunity to select a party af-12 filiation or to select their status as "unaffiliated," the poll book for the 13 2012 primary election shall include checkoff boxes by which the poll worker 14 or other appropriate election personnel shall record such elector's choice 15 16 of party affiliation or choice to be designated as "unaffiliated." After the 2012 primary election, the county clerk shall record the party affiliation 17 or "unaffiliated" designation so selected in the poll book as part of such 18 an elector's record within the voter registration system as provided for in 19 section 34-437A, Idaho Code. 20

(56) After the 2012 primary election, electors who remain registered
voters and who did not vote in the 2012 primary election or who have not
selected party affiliation or who have not selected to be designated as
"unaffiliated," shall be designated as "unaffiliated" and the county clerk
shall record that designation for each such elector within the voter registration system as provided for in section 34-437A, Idaho Code.

SECTION 3. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after
 July 1, 2023.
