AN ACT

1 RELATING TO SCHOOL DISTRICTS; AMENDING SECTION 33-320, IDAHO CODE, TO RE-  
2 VISE THE NAME OF A CERTAIN PLAN AND TO REVISE PROVISIONS RELATING TO SUCH  
3 PLAN.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. That Section 33-320, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
7 amended to read as follows:

8 33-320. ~~STRATEGIC PLANNING~~ CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT PLANS AND TRAIN-  
9 ING. (1) Each school district and public charter school in Idaho shall  
10 develop ~~and maintain a strategic~~ an annual plan that is part of a continuous  
11 ~~focuses on improving the student performance of the district or public char-~~  
12 ~~ter school.~~

13 (2) (a) The board of trustees and the superintendent shall collaborate  
14 on the plan and engage students, parents, educators and the community as  
15 appropriate. The board of directors and the administrator of a public  
16 charter school shall collaborate on the plan and engage students, par-  
17 ents, educators and the community as appropriate.

18 (b) The ~~strategie~~ annual continuous improvement plan shall:

19 (i) Be data driven, specifically in student outcomes, and shall  
20 include, but not be limited to, analyses of demographic data, stu-  
21 dent achievement and growth data, graduation rates, and college  
22 and career readiness;

23 (ii) Set clear and measurable targets based on student outcomes;

24 (iii) Include a clearly developed and articulated vision and mis-  
25 sion; ~~and~~

26 (iv) Include key indicators for monitoring performance; and

27 (v) Include a report of progress toward the previous year's im-  
28 provement goals.

29 (c) ~~For the 2014-2015 school year, the strategic plan shall be adopted~~  
30 ~~on or before September 1. The ~~strategie~~ annual continuous improvement~~  
31 ~~plan must be reviewed and updated annually no later than August 1 every~~  
32 ~~each year thereafter.~~

33 (d) The board of trustees or the board of directors shall continuously  
34 monitor progress toward the goals by utilizing relevant data to measure  
35 growth. The progress shall be included in evaluations of the district  
36 superintendent or administrator of a public charter school.

37 (3) The ~~strategie~~ plan must be made available to the public and shall be  
38 posted on the school district or charter school website.

39 (4) Of the moneys appropriated in the public schools educational sup-  
40 port program, up to ~~two~~ six thousand six hundred dollars (\$~~2,06,600~~) shall be  
41 distributed to each school district and public charter school to be expended  
42 for training purposes for district superintendents and boards of trustees,

1 public charter school administrators and boards of directors. Funds shall  
2 be distributed on a reimbursement basis based on a process prescribed by the  
3 superintendent of public instruction. Qualified training shall include  
4 training for continuous improvement processes and planning, strategic plan-  
5 ning, finance, superintendent evaluations, public charter administrator  
6 evaluations, ethics and governance.

7 (5) The state board of education shall be granted rulemaking author-  
8 ity to establish appropriate procedures, qualifications and guidelines for  
9 qualified training providers and shall prepare a list of qualified training  
10 providers within the state of Idaho.
