2	RELATING TO EDUCATION AND THE MASTERY ADVANCEMENT PILOT PROGRAM; AMENDING
3	SECTION 33-1621, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE PROVISIONS RELATING TO PROGRAM
4	PARTICIPANTS.
5	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:
6	SECTION 1. That Section 33-1621, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
7	amended to read as follows:
3	33-1621. PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS. (1) No more than twenty-one (21)
))	school districts and no more than three (3) charter schools may participate
, 10	in the program. Participating districts shall be determined through an ap-
11	plication process established by the state department of education.
12	(2) The program shall be divided into three (3) geographical regions of
13	the state in the following manner:
14	(a) Region I shall be comprised of Idaho high school activities associ-
15	ation regions I and II;
16	(b) Region II shall be comprised of Idaho high school activities asso-
17	ciation region III; and
18	(c) Region III shall be comprised of Idaho high school activities asso-
19	ciation regions IV, V and VI.
20	(3) Participating school districts shall reflect the disparate sizes
21	of school districts within this state. Participating school districts shall
22	be selected in the following manner:
23	(a) Any school district and any charter school desiring to participate
24	in the program shall submit an application to the state department of
25	education by September 1, 2010. Such application shall be developed
26	by the state department of education and shall be made available to the
27	state's school districts and charter schools by July 15, 2010. From the
28	applicants, the department shall select:
29	(i) Three (3) school districts, one (1) from each program re-
30	gion, that have grades 1-12 enrollment of more than seven thousand
31	(7,000) students;
32	(ii) Six (6) school districts, two (2) from each program region,
33	that have grades 1-12 enrollment of between four thousand (4,000)
34	and six thousand nine hundred ninety-nine (6,999) students;
35	(iii) Six (6) school districts, two (2) from each program region,
36	that have grades 1-12 enrollment of between one thousand (1,000)
37	and three thousand nine hundred ninety-nine (3,999) students;
38	(iv) Six (6) school districts, two (2) from each program region,
39	that have grades 1-12 enrollment of less than one thousand (1,000)
40	students; and
41	(v) Three (3) charter schools, one (1) from each program region.

(b) The state department of education shall notify selected program applicants by December 1, 2010.

(c) School districts and charter schools selected for the program will be expected to participate for the full six (6) years of the program. Provided however, that any school district or charter school selected for the program may request to the state department of education to opt out of the program. The department may grant such request at its discretion.

 $(4\underline{3})$ No participating school district shall be required to implement the program on a districtwide basis. It shall be left to the discretion of each participating district to determine which schools in the district shall participate.
