Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 48, Title 39, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 39-4806, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

- 39-4806. USE OF IMMUNIZATION REGISTRY BY IMMUNIZATION PROVIDERS. (1) Any person licensed under title 54, Idaho Code, who administers immunizations in Idaho shall be required to enter all immunizations, with the exception of influenza vaccines administered to persons nineteen (19) years of age and older, into the Idaho immunization reminder information system created pursuant to section 39-4803, Idaho Code. Immunization providers shall have up to twenty-eight (28) days after administration to enter immunizations into the system.
- (2) Nothing in this section shall deny adult patients or the parent, guardian or other person legally responsible for the care of a child the right to opt out of inclusion in the Idaho immunization reminder information system pursuant to section 39-4803, Idaho Code.
- (3) Professional licensing boards established under title 54, Idaho Code, may enforce the provisions of this chapter in accordance with applicable law.
