HOUSE BILL NO. 112

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO THE HONEY ADVERTISING COMMISSION; AMENDING SECTION 22-2804,  
2 IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE COMPENSATION PROVISIONS REGARDING THE COMMIS-  
3 SION.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. That Section 22-2804, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
7 amended to read as follows:

8 22-2804. COMMISSION, MEMBERS, APPOINTMENT AND COMPENSATION. There  
9 is hereby created and established in the department of agriculture an Idaho  
10 honey advertising commission to be known and designated as such, and shall be  
11 composed of the director of the department and three (3) members, who shall  
12 be practical honey producers or beekeepers, appointed by the governor, at  
13 the recommendation of a representative group of beekeepers of the state of  
14 Idaho. Each member so appointed shall be a resident citizen of the state  
15 of Idaho and from the district from which appointed, for a period of five  
16 (5) years prior to his appointment, and shall have had active experience in  
17 raising honey bees and each member shall have derived the major portion of  
18 his income from the production and sale of honey. One (1) member shall be  
19 chosen from the district north of the Salmon River; one (1) from the district  
20 south of the Salmon River and west of a north-south line bisecting the city of  
21 Shoshone and extending from the south boundary of the state of Idaho to the  
22 Salmon River; one (1) from the district south of the Salmon River and east  
23 of a north-south line bisecting the city of Shoshone and extending from the  
24 south boundary of the state of Idaho to the Salmon River. Commission members  
25 shall be appointed and serve for a term of three (3) years and until their  
26 respective successors are appointed and qualified. The commission shall  
27 elect its chairman.

28 The chairman of the commission may delegate the function of the honey  
29 advertising commission to an executive secretary whose function will be sub-  
30 ject to the approval of the honey advertising commission. The executive sec-  
31 retary must be a member of the Idaho honey industry association, inc., or its  
32 successor organization but need not be a member of the honey advertising com-  
33 mission.

34 A majority of the members of said commission shall constitute a quorum  
35 for the transaction of all business and the carrying out of the duties of said  
36 commission. Before entering on the discharge of their duties as members of  
37 said commission, each member shall take and subscribe to the oath of office  
38 prescribed by the statutes of Idaho.

39 Each member of the commission shall be compensated as provided by sec-  
40 tion 59-509(~~an~~), Idaho Code. The commission shall meet regularly once each  
41 fiscal year at a date established by said commission in its designated busi-

1   ness office, and it shall fix the time and place of special meetings as may be  
2   deemed necessary by the chairman of the commission.
