AN ACT

1 RELATING TO FISH AND GAME; AMENDING SECTION 36-413, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE
2 FOR TRAPPING LICENSE CERTIFICATES, TO PROVIDE CORRECT CODE REFERENCES,
3 AND TO MAKE A TECHNICAL CORRECTION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PRO-
4 VIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 SECTION 1. That Section 36-413, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
8 amended to read as follows:

9 36-413. LIFETIME LICENSE CERTIFICATE -- FEE. (a) The fish and game
10 commission shall issue rules and regulations to administer a lifetime li-
11 cense certificate system.

12 (b) A lifetime license certificate may be sold to any person who quali-
13 fies as a resident or is granted resident license privileges as provided in
14 subsection (s) of section 36-202, Idaho Code.

15 (c) A lifetime certificate may be obtained by a person one (1) day of age
16 through one (1) year of age possessing the qualifications therein described
17 upon payment of: twenty-five (25) times the fee prescribed for a combined
18 hunting and fishing license in section ~~36-406~~ 36-416(a), Idaho Code, for a
19 combined hunting and fishing license certificate; twenty-five (25) times
20 the fee prescribed for a hunting license in section ~~36-406~~ 36-416(a), Idaho
21 Code, for a hunting license certificate; ~~or~~ twenty-five (25) times the
22 fee prescribed for a fishing license in section ~~36-406~~ 36-416(a), Idaho
23 Code, for a fishing license certificate; or twenty-five (25) times the fee
24 prescribed for a trapping license in section 36-416(a), Idaho Code, for a
25 trapping license certificate.

26 (d) A lifetime certificate may be obtained by a person two (2) years of
27 age through fifty (50) years of age possessing the qualifications therein
28 described upon payment of: thirty-five (35) times the fee prescribed for
29 a combined hunting and fishing license in section ~~36-406~~ 36-416(a), Idaho
30 Code, for a combined hunting and fishing license certificate; thirty-five
31 (35) times the fee prescribed for a hunting license in section ~~36-406~~
32 36-416(a), Idaho Code, for a hunting license certificate; ~~or~~ thirty-five
33 (35) times the fee prescribed for a fishing license in section ~~36-406~~
34 36-416(a), Idaho Code, for a fishing license certificate; or thirty-five
35 (35) times the fee prescribed for a trapping license in section 36-416(a),
36 Idaho Code, for a trapping license certificate.

37 (e) A lifetime certificate may be obtained by a person fifty-one (51)
38 years of age or older possessing the qualifications therein described upon
39 payment of: twenty (20) times the fee prescribed for a combined hunting
40 and fishing license in section ~~36-406~~ 36-416(a), Idaho Code, for a combined
41 hunting and fishing license certificate; twenty (20) times the fee pre-
42 scribed for a hunting license in section ~~36-406~~ 36-416(a), Idaho Code, for a

1 hunting license certificate; ~~or~~ twenty (20) times the fee prescribed for a
2 fishing license in section ~~36-406~~ 36-416(a), Idaho Code, for a fishing li-
3 cense certificate; or twenty (20) times the fee prescribed for a trapping li-
4 cence in section 36-416(a), Idaho Code, for a trapping license certificate.

5 (f) Holders of lifetime license certificates shall be subject to the
6 provisions of title 36, Idaho Code.

7 (g) The director shall promptly transmit to the state treasurer all
8 moneys received by him from the sale of lifetime license certificates and
9 the state treasurer shall deposit all such moneys in the fish and game trust
10 ~~account~~ fund. All such moneys shall be expended at the direction of the com-
11 mission to carry out the purposes of the Idaho fish and game code or any law
12 or regulation promulgated for the protection of wildlife, and shall be used
13 for no other purpose.

14 SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
15 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after
16 July 1, 2023.
