means a United States citizen who has attained or will attain the age of eighteen (18) years by the date of an election at which the citizen proposes to vote and who does not qualify as a resident of this state under section 34-107, Idaho Code, but who was registered to vote and was a resident of the state immediately prior to departure from the United States, and who is not registered to vote or voting in any other state, territory or possession.
17 (3) An overseas elector may vote in any election for candidates for fed-

eral office, including the partisan primary and any special primary or elec tion. Such elector may not vote for any state or local offices or issues, ex cept military personnel and spouses of military personnel as provided in 50
 U.S.C. App. 595. An overseas elector shall vote in the precinct in which the
 elector was last a resident and registered to vote prior to departure from
 the United States.
