# Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 1, Chapter 105, Laws of 2018, and any other appropriation provided by law, there is hereby appropriated to the Division of Veterans Services the following amounts to be expended according to the designated expense classes from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2018, through June 30, 2019:

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the appropriation made to the Division of Veterans Services in Section 1, Chapter 105, Laws of 2018, from the Miscellaneous Revenue Fund is hereby reduced by \$1,200,000 for personnel costs for the period July 1, 2018, through June 30, 2019.

SECTION 3. CASH TRANSFER. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 65-703(2), Idaho Code, or any other provision of law to the contrary, there is hereby appropriated and the administrator of the Division of Veterans Services shall request the State Controller to make a transfer or transfers from the Idaho Veterans Recognition Fund to the Idaho Veterans Recognition Income Fund in an amount not to exceed a total of \$800,000 for the purpose of providing the state's required match for the establishment of a fourth veterans home in north Idaho for the period July 1, 2018, through June 30, 2019. Further, notwithstanding the provisions of Section 65-704(5), Idaho Code, or any other provision of law to the contrary, any funds remaining in the Veterans Recognition Income Fund at the end of fiscal year 2019 shall remain

- in the Veterans Recognition Income Fund and shall not be transferred back to the Idaho Veterans Recognition Fund.
- 3 SECTION 4. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby 4 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its 5 passage and approval.
