- RELATING TO EDUCATION; AMENDING CHAPTER 1, TITLE 33, IDAHO CODE, BY THE AD DITION OF A NEW SECTION 33-141, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE FOR THE DISPLAY OF
 THE NATIONAL MOTTO IN CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY
 AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 1, Title 33, Idaho Code, be, and the same is
hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 33-141, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

- 10 33-141. NATIONAL MOTTO. (1) An educational institution under the general supervision, governance, or control of the state board of education or the board of regents of the university of Idaho must display a durable poster or a framed copy of a representation of the national motto, "In God We Trust," in a conspicuous place if:
- (a) Such poster or framed copy includes a representation of the United
 States flag or a representation of the flag of the state of Idaho, or
 both;

(b) The background, lettering, and framing on the poster or framed copyinclude only black, white, gold, or silver;

- 20 (c) Such poster or framed copy was donated to the institution;
- (d) Such poster and framing do not contain any other lettering, ver biage, images, logos, or likeness other than that required by this sec tion;
- (e) Such poster and framing do not contain any markings identifying thedonor of the poster; and
- (f) The size of the poster or framed copy is approved by the educationalinstitution.

(2) A poster or framed copy that meets the requirements of subsection
(1) (a) and (b) of this section may be purchased from private donations and
made available to an institution pursuant to subsection (1) of this section.

31 SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby 32 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after 33 July 1, 2023.
