HOUSE BILL NO. 226

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO EDUCATION; AMENDING SECTION 33-1002C, IDAHO CODE, TO ESTABLISH
2 PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE USE OF FULL-TERM AVERAGE DAILY ATTENDANCE TO
3 CALCULATE SUPPORT UNITS FOR CERTAIN ALTERNATIVE SECONDARY SCHOOLS AND
4 TO PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN SUPPORT UNITS SHALL BE USED FOR ALL STATE FUND-
5 ING FORMULAS IN WHICH SUPPORT UNITS ARE USED.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

8 SECTION 1. That Section 33-1002C, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
9 amended to read as follows:

10 33-1002C. SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAM SUPPORT UNITS -- ALTERNATIVE SEC-
11 ONDARY SCHOOL -- JUVENILE DETENTION FACILITY. (1) Alternative secondary
12 summer school programs of not less than two hundred twenty-five (225) hours
13 of instruction, which shall be included in the educational support units
14 calculated as provided in section 33-1002, Idaho Code, may be established
15 as approved by the state board of education. The average daily attendance
16 divided by forty (40) shall determine the number of allowable support units
17 which shall be included in the alternative school secondary support units
18 calculated for the school district for the succeeding school term.

19 (2) For any alternative secondary school designated pursuant to sec-
20 tion 46-805, Idaho Code, full-term average daily attendance shall be used to
21 calculate support units for each cohort of students that meets the minimum
22 instructional hours requirement provided for in section 33-512, Idaho Code.
23 The support units so calculated shall be used for all state funding formulas
24 in which support units are used.

25 (3) Districts which educate pupils placed by court order in a juvenile
26 detention facility may establish a summer school program which shall be in-
27 cluded in the educational support units calculated as provided in section
28 33-1002, Idaho Code. The average daily attendance divided by forty (40)
29 shall determine the number of allowable support units which shall be in-
30 cluded in the exceptional education school support units calculated for the
31 school district for the succeeding school term.

32 (34) Average daily attendance and the support units so generated by
33 this section shall not be included in or subject to the provisions of section
34 33-1003, Idaho Code, and shall be included as an addition to any other sup-
35 port units generated pursuant to Idaho Code.
