AN ACT

2 APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE COMMISSION FOR PARDONS AND PAROLE FOR

3 FISCAL YEAR 2011; APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE COMMISSION FOR PARDONS

4 AND PAROLE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2012; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF FULL-TIME EQUIV
5 ALENT POSITIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 2, Chapter 242, Laws of 2010, and any other appropriation provided for by law, there is hereby appropriated to the Commission for Pardons and Parole \$50,000 from the Miscellaneous Revenue Fund to be expended for the period July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2011.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Commission for Pardons and Parole, the following amounts to be expended for the designated expense classes, from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2011, through June 30, 2012:

SECTION 3. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519, Idaho Code, the Commission for Pardons and Parole is authorized no more than thirty-two (32) full-time equivalent positions at any point during the period July 1, 2011, through June 30, 2012, unless specifically authorized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly of any increased positions so authorized.

SECTION 4. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, Section 1 of this act shall be in full force and effect on and after passage and approval.
