2 RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES FOR
3 FISCAL YEAR 2020; APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER
4 RESOURCES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED
5 FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS; APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING MON6 EYS FROM THE REVOLVING DEVELOPMENT FUND TO THE AQUIFER PLANNING AND
7 MANAGEMENT FUND; AND TRANSFERRING MONEYS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE
8 SECONDARY AQUIFER PLANNING, MANAGEMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION FUND.

9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

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SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Water Resources the following amounts to be expended according to the designated programs and expense classes from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2020:

35 SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519,
 36 Idaho Code, the Department of Water Resources is authorized no more than one
 37 hundred sixty-three (163.00) full-time equivalent positions at any point

during the period July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2020, unless specifically authorized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly of any increased positions so authorized.

SECTION 3. CASH TRANSFER FOR AQUIFER MONITORING, MEASUREMENT, AND MODELING. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Water Resources and
the State Controller shall transfer \$716,000 from the Revolving Development
Fund to the Aquifer Planning and Management Fund on July 1, 2019, or as soon
thereafter as practicable, for the period July 1, 2019, through June 30,
2020, to be used for aquifer monitoring, measurement, and modeling.

SECTION 4. CASH TRANSFER FOR AQUIFER MANAGEMENT. Of the amount appropriated to the Department of Water Resources in Section 1 of this act for the Planning and Technical Services Program from the General Fund for lump sum, the State Controller shall transfer \$5,000,000 to the Secondary Aquifer Planning, Management and Implementation Fund on July 1, 2019, or as soon thereafter as practicable, for the period July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2020, to be used for aquifer recharge and management.
