SECTION 1. That Title 33, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended
by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW CHAPTER</u>, to be known and designated as Chapter 61, Title 33, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

CHAPTER 61 EDUCATION FREEDOM ACT

33-6101. ELIMINATION OF FEDERAL FUNDING IN EDUCATION. Beginning in 12 fiscal year 2019, the state of Idaho will limit the amount, and reject any ex-13 cess, of federal education funding included in the state's appropriation for 14 education in grades K-12. In fiscal year 2019, the state of Idaho will accept 15 up to three hundred million dollars (\$300,000,000) in federal education 16 funding. Such limit shall be reduced by forty million dollars (\$40,000,000) 17 every year thereafter until fiscal year 2027, when Idaho no longer relies 18 19 on federal funding for any of Idaho's grades K-12 education appropriations. Once attained, Idaho will retain its education freedom by not allowing fed-20 eral funding for any of its future grades K-12 education appropriations. 21
