5	RELIGIOUS BELIEFS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 59, Title 67, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 67-5909B, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

67-5909B. RIGHT TO REFUSE MEDICAL TREATMENT BASED ON RELIGIOUS BE-LIEFS. Any person may refuse medical treatment of any kind based on the person's religious beliefs. No governmental entity, employer, or any other entity may question the sincerity of the religious beliefs claimed by a person. Government, employers, and other entities may adopt forms upon which the religious exemption is claimed, which may include a waiver by the person claiming the religious exemption of liability or any other responsibility on the part of the government, employer, or other entity for the person's refusal of medical treatment.

SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage and approval.
