- 7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:
- 8 SECTION 1. That Chapter 3, Title 58, Idaho Code, be, and the same is 9 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and des-10 ignated as Section 58-304B, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:
 - 58-304B. LEASES -- LAND USE PERMITS -- LAND USE AGREEMENTS -- REMEDIATION. All leases, land use permits, or other land use agreements of state land entered into by the state board of land commissioners shall provide standard terms and conditions for maintenance and repair of the land by the lease, permit, or contract holder during the term of the agreement and shall also include provisions for remediation by the contracting party to address any damage to state lands that exceed the agreement's terms and conditions at the completion of the agreement.
- SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2024.
