- RELATING TO MODULAR BUILDINGS; AMENDING SECTION 39-4301, IDAHO CODE, TO
 REVISE DEFINITIONS; AMENDING SECTION 39-4304, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE
 PROVISIONS RELATING TO PLACEMENT OF AN INSIGNIA OF APPROVAL; AMEND ING CHAPTER 43, TITLE 39, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION
 39-4304B, IDAHO CODE, TO ESTABLISH PROVISIONS RELATING TO CERTAIN PER MITS AND INSPECTIONS RELATING TO MODULAR BUILDING INSTALLATIONS.
- 8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

9 SECTION 1. That Section 39-4301, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 10 amended to read as follows:

11 39-4301. DEFINITIONS. As used in this chapter:

(1) "Administrator" means the administrator of the division of build-ing safety for the state of Idaho.

(2) "Board" means the modular building advisory board, as created insection 39-4302, Idaho Code.

(3) "Building site" means any tract, parcel or subdivision of land uponwhich a modular building is installed or is to be installed.

(4) "Closed construction" means any manufactured building or build ing component which may enclose factory installed structural, mechanical,
 electrical or plumbing systems and is not open for visual inspection at the
 building site.

(5) "Commercial coach" means a modular building with permanent running
 gear and a hitch assembly that is designed and constructed for nonresiden tial occupancy classifications only.

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(6) "Division" means the Idaho division of building safety.

(7) <u>"Local government" means any city or county of this state.</u>

(8) "Modular building" means any building or building component, other
 than a manufactured or mobile home, which is of closed construction and is
 either entirely or substantially prefabricated or assembled at a place other
 than the building site. "Modular building" does not include recreational
 park trailers installed in recreational vehicle parks or utilized by the
 owner for the intended purpose of its design and construction as defined in
 this section, including appropriate occupancy uses.

(9) "Recreational park trailers" means a trailer-type unit that is
 primarily designed and constructed to provide temporary living quarters for
 recreational, camping or seasonal use that meets the following criteria:
 built on a single chassis, mounted on wheels; having a gross trailer area not
 exceeding four hundred (400) square feet in the set-up mode; and certified by
 the manufacturer as complying with ANSI A119.5.

40 SECTION 2. That Section 39-4304, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 41 amended to read as follows: 39-4304. INSIGNIA OF APPROVAL -- COST -- PLACEMENT. (1) No modular
 building shall be installed on a building site in this state on or after July
 1, 2007, unless it is approved and bears the insignia of approval of the di vision.

5 (2) Any modular building bearing an insignia of approval of the divi6 sion shall be deemed to comply with codes, laws, or rules enacted by the state
7 of Idaho which govern the manufacture and construction of such building.

8 (3) The cost of the insignia, if issued, shall be included as a part of9 the permit fee as set forth in section 39-4303, Idaho Code.

(4) No modular building which has been approved by the division shall
 be in any way modified prior to its initial occupancy unless approval of that
 modification is first made by the division.

(5) Insignias shall be placed on the front, left-hand side of the build ing as prescribed by administrative rule promulgated by the board.

15 SECTION 3. That Chapter 43, Title 39, Idaho Code, be, and the same is 16 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and des-17 ignated as Section 39-4304B, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

18 39-4304B. INSTALLATION PERMITS -- INSPECTIONS -- FEES. In order to 19 complete the installation of a modular building, approval and inspection of 20 such installation by the enforcement authority having jurisdiction over the 21 site location shall be required. The owner, dealer or installer of a modu-22 lar building must obtain an installation permit before installing a modular 23 building on a building site.

(1) Permits shall be issued by the division of building safety for installation in areas where a local government does not administer a building
code enforcement program or from local governments whose building inspectors hold valid inspector certifications as required by section 39-4108,
Idaho Code.

(2) Fees for installation permits shall be paid in an amount as pre scribed by administrative rule promulgated by the board or as prescribed by
 the local government administering building codes, as applicable.

(3) Inspections conducted by the division shall be recorded on an in spection record form and a copy shall be provided to the property owner upon
 completion of the inspection.

(4) All installations must be inspected with the exception of commer cial coaches located on active construction sites for use as construction
 offices or storage facilities for not more than two hundred forty (240) days.
 Extensions of additional days for such may be authorized upon demonstrated
 cause.
