- 5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. That Section 33-3723, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 7 amended to read as follows:

8 33-3723. RURAL PHYSICIAN INCENTIVE FEE ASSESSMENT. The state board of education may assess a fee to students preparing to be physicians in the 9 fields of medicine or osteopathic medicine who are supported by the state 10 pursuant to an interstate compact for a professional education program in 11 those fields, as those fields are defined by the compact. The fee may not 12 exceed an amount equal to four percent (4%) of the annual average medicine 13 support fee paid by the state. The fee must be assessed by the board and 14 deposited in the rural physician incentive fund established in section 15 39-5902, Idaho Code, to be administered by the department of health and 16 welfare. Moneys are also payable into the fund from state appropriations, 17 private contributions, gifts and grants and other sources. Income and earn-18 ings on the fund shall be returned to the fund. Subject to appropriation, the 19 state shall match student contributions to the fund at a rate of two state 20 dollars (\$2.00) for every one dollar (\$1.00) assessed as a student fee. The 21 22 expenses of administering the physician incentive fund portion of the fund shall not exceed ten percent (10%) of the annual fees assessed pursuant to 23 24 this section.
