AN ACT

1 RELATING TO THE PERSONNEL SYSTEM; AMENDING CHAPTER 53, TITLE 67, IDAHO CODE,  
2 BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 67-5333A, IDAHO CODE, TO ESTABLISH PRO-  
3 VISIONS RELATING TO SICK LEAVE OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF IDAHO COMMUNITY  
4 COLLEGES; AMENDING CHAPTER 53, TITLE 67, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF  
5 A NEW SECTION 67-5333B, IDAHO CODE, TO ESTABLISH PROVISIONS RELATING TO  
6 SICK LEAVE AND CERTAIN FORMER EMPLOYEES OF SELLAND COLLEGE OF APPLIED  
7 TECHNOLOGY AT BOISE STATE UNIVERSITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

10 SECTION 1. That Chapter 53, Title 67, Idaho Code, be, and the same is  
11 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a NEW SECTION, to be known and des-  
12 ignated as Section 67-5333A, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

13 67-5333A. SICK LEAVE TRANSFERRED -- COMMUNITY COLLEGES -- STATE EM-  
14 PLOYMENT. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, any  
15 employee who has accrued sick leave while in the employment of one (1) of  
16 Idaho's community colleges and who, on or after January 1, 2012, is trans-  
17 ferred to or otherwise becomes an eligible employee of a state of Idaho edu-  
18 cational agency immediately following termination of employment with a com-  
19 munity college shall be credited by the state of Idaho with the amount of sick  
20 leave accrued and unused, up to a maximum of ninety (90) days, upon commence-  
21 ment of state employment. After such transfer, the use of sick leave shall be  
22 governed by the laws and rules applicable to state employees and any appli-  
23 cable policies of the state agency or entity thereafter employing such em-  
24 ployee.

25 SECTION 2. That Chapter 53, Title 67, Idaho Code, be, and the same is  
26 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a NEW SECTION, to be known and des-  
27 ignated as Section 67-5333B, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

28 67-5333B. SICK LEAVE TRANSFERRED -- FORMER EMPLOYEES OF SELLAND  
29 COLLEGE OF APPLIED TECHNOLOGY AT BOISE STATE UNIVERSITY -- STATE EMPLOY-  
30 MENT. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, any former  
31 employee of Selland college of applied technology at Boise state university  
32 (BSU) whose sick leave accumulated at BSU and was transferred to the college  
33 of western Idaho (CWI) pursuant to section 33-2109B, Idaho Code, and who,  
34 on or before September 1, 2012, was transferred to or otherwise became an  
35 eligible employee of the state of Idaho immediately following termination of  
36 employment with CWI shall be credited by the state of Idaho with the amount of  
37 sick leave transferred to CWI from BSU that remains unused, upon commence-  
38 ment of state employment. After such transfer, the use of sick leave shall  
39 be governed by the laws and rules applicable to state employees and by any

1 applicable policies of the state agency or entity thereafter employing such  
2 employee.

3 SECTION 3. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby  
4 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its  
5 passage and approval.
