AN ACT

1 RELATING TO PLAN FIRST IDAHO; AMENDING SECTION 56-262, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE
2 A CODE REFERENCE; AMENDING CHAPTER 2, TITLE 56, IDAHO CODE, BY THE AD-
3 DITION OF A NEW SECTION 56-267, IDAHO CODE, TO ESTABLISH PROVISIONS RE-
4 GARDING PLAN FIRST IDAHO; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 SECTION 1. That Section 56-262, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
8 amended to read as follows:

9 56-262. DEFINITIONS. The definitions contained in section 56-252,
10 Idaho Code, shall apply to sections 56-260 through 56-266~~7~~, Idaho Code.

11 SECTION 2. That Chapter 2, Title 56, Idaho Code, be, and the same is
12 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a NEW SECTION, to be known and des-
13 ignated as Section 56-267, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

14 56-267. PLAN FIRST IDAHO. (1) There is hereby established in the
15 department "Plan First Idaho," under which program the department shall
16 provide medical assistance for family planning services and supplies and
17 preconception planning to women aged nineteen (19) to forty-four (44) years
18 whose family income does not exceed one hundred thirty-three percent (133%)
19 of the federal poverty guideline, who meet other eligibility standards in
20 accordance with department rule, and who are not insured by medicare, medic-
21 aid or other health insurance that covers family planning services.

22 (2) Family planning services and supplies do not include abortions.

23 (3) The department shall provide the assistance described in subsec-
24 tion (1) of this section upon federal approval of a waiver application. Pro-
25 vision of the assistance is contingent on such approval.

26 (4) The department is required and authorized to take all actions nec-
27 essary to implement the provisions of this section.

28 SECTION 3. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
29 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its
30 passage and approval.
