AN ACT

1 RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT PRO-  
2 GRAM/DIVISION OF ADMINISTRATORS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017; PROVIDING FOR EX-  
3 PENDITURES TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT PROGRAM/DIVISION  
4 OF ADMINISTRATORS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017; APPROPRIATING GENERAL FUND MON-  
5 EYS FOR TRANSFER TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOL INCOME FUND; APPROPRIATING FUNDS  
6 TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT PROGRAM/DIVISION OF ADMINIS-  
7 TRATORS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017; AMENDING SECTION 33-1004E, IDAHO CODE, TO  
8 INCREASE THE BASE SALARY FOR ADMINISTRATORS; AND LIMITING THE DISTRIBU-  
9 TION TO SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND CHARTER SCHOOLS FOR CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT  
10 PLANNING AND TRAINING.

12 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

13 SECTION 1. The following amount shall be expended for the Public  
14 Schools Educational Support Program/Division of Administrators for the pe-  
15 riod July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017:

18 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated the following amount to be  
19 transferred to the Public School Income Fund for the period July 1, 2016,  
20 through June 30, 2017:

23 SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Public Schools Educa-  
24 tional Support Program/Division of Administrators the following amount to  
25 be expended from the listed fund for the period July 1, 2016, through June 30,  
26 2017:

29 SECTION 4. That Section 33-1004E, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
30 amended to read as follows:

31 33-1004E. DISTRICT'S SALARY-BASED APPORTIONMENT. Each district shall  
32 be entitled to a salary-based apportionment calculated as provided in this  
33 section.

1           (1) To determine the apportionment for instructional staff, take  
2 the amounts indicated on the career ladder table plus the amounts associ-  
3 ated with the additional education allocation amounts pursuant to section  
4 33-1004B, Idaho Code, and calculate the weighted average. The amount so  
5 determined shall be multiplied by the district staff allowance for instruc-  
6 tional staff determined as provided in section 33-1004(2), Idaho Code.  
7 Full-time instructional staff salaries shall be determined from a salary  
8 schedule developed by each district and submitted to the state department of  
9 education. No full-time instructional staff member shall be paid less than  
10 the minimum dollar amount on the career ladder residency compensation rung  
11 pursuant to section 33-1004B, Idaho Code, for the applicable fiscal year.  
12 If an instructional staff member has been certified by the national board  
13 for professional teaching standards, the staff member shall receive two  
14 thousand dollars (\$2,000) per year for five (5) years from the year in which  
15 national board certification was earned. The district staff allotment shall  
16 be increased by two thousand dollars (\$2,000) for each national board cer-  
17 tified instructional staff person and pupil service staff member who earned  
18 national board certification; provided however, that no such awards shall be  
19 paid for the period July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2011, nor shall any lia-  
20 bilities accrue or payments be made pursuant to this section in the future to  
21 any individuals who would have otherwise qualified for a payment during this  
22 stated time period. The resulting amount is the district's salary-based  
23 apportionment for instructional staff and pupil service staff. For purposes  
24 of this section, teachers qualifying for the salary increase shall be those  
25 who have been recognized as national board certified teachers as of July 1 of  
26 each year.

27           (2) To determine the apportionment for pupil service staff, first de-  
28 termine the district average experience and education index by placing all  
29 eligible district certificated pupil service employees on the statewide  
30 index pursuant to section 33-1004A, Idaho Code. The resulting average is  
31 the district index. The district pupil service staff index shall be multi-  
32 plied by the instructional base salary of twenty-four thousand fifty-five  
33 dollars (\$24,055). The amount so determined shall be multiplied by the dis-  
34 trict staff allowance for pupil service staff determined pursuant to section  
35 33-1004(3), Idaho Code. The pupil service staff salary allocation shall  
36 be further increased by the amount necessary for each full-time equivalent  
37 pupil service staff member placed on the experience and education index to be  
38 allocated at least the minimum salary mandated by this section. Full-time  
39 pupil service staff salaries shall be determined from a salary schedule de-  
40 veloped by each district and submitted to the state department of education.  
41 The resulting amount is the district's salary-based apportionment for pupil  
42 service staff. No full-time pupil service staff member shall be paid less  
43 than thirty-two thousand seven hundred three dollars (\$32,703).

44           (3) To determine the apportionment for district administrative staff,  
45 first determine the district average experience and education index by plac-  
46 ing all eligible certificated administrative employees on the statewide in-  
47 dex provided in section 33-1004A, Idaho Code. The resulting average is the  
48 district index. Districts with an index above the state average index shall  
49 receive their actual index but not more than the state average plus .03 for  
50 the school year 1994-95, and shall receive their actual index but not more

1 than the state average index plus .06 for the 1995-96 school year, and there-  
2 after shall receive their actual district index. The district administra-  
3 tive staff index shall be multiplied by the base salary of thirty-~~three~~four  
4 thousand one hundred ~~sixteen~~ nine dollars (~~\$33,116~~34,109). The amount so  
5 determined shall be multiplied by the district staff allowance for adminis-  
6 trative staff determined as provided in section 33-1004(4), Idaho Code. The  
7 resulting amount is the district's salary-based apportionment for adminis-  
8 trative staff.

9 (4) To determine the apportionment for classified staff, multi-  
10 ply nineteen thousand eight hundred twenty-six dollars (\$19,826) by the  
11 district classified staff allowance determined as provided in section  
12 33-1004(5), Idaho Code. The amount so determined is the district's appor-  
13 tionment for classified staff.

14 (5) The district's salary-based apportionment shall be the sum of the  
15 apportionments calculated in subsections (1), (2), (3) and (4) of this sec-  
16 tion, plus the benefit apportionment as provided in section 33-1004F, Idaho  
17 Code.

18 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the Legislature that  
19 notwithstanding Section 33-320, Idaho Code, the distribution to each school  
20 district and charter school for continuous improvement planning and train-  
21 ing shall be up to \$4,000 for the period July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017.
