8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 1, Title 33, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a  $\underline{\text{NEW SECTION}}$ , to be known and designated as Section 33-107E, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

33-107E. SPEECH ON CAMPUS. Except as otherwise permitted by the first amendment to the United States constitution, no public institution of higher education shall abridge the constitutional freedom of any individual, including enrolled students, faculty and other employees, and invited guests, to speak on campus. As used in this section, "public institution of higher education" means a public postsecondary organization governed or supervised by the state board of education, the board of regents of the university of Idaho, a board of trustees of a community college established pursuant to the provisions of chapter 21, title 33, Idaho Code, or the state board for career technical education.
