APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION AND THE BOARD OF RE-2 GENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF IDAHO FOR COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITIES AND THE 3 OFFICE OF THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017; PROVIDING 4 NON-GENERAL FUND REAPPROPRIATION; PROVIDING LEGISLATIVE INTENT FOR 5 SYSTEMWIDE NEEDS; PROVIDING LEGISLATIVE INTENT FOR REPORTING RELATED 6 TO THE COMPLETE COLLEGE IDAHO INITIATIVE; PROVIDING LEGISLATIVE INTENT 7 FOR THE CYBERSECURITY LAB; AND EXEMPTING APPROPRIATION OBJECT AND PRO-8 GRAM TRANSFER LIMITATIONS. 9

10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

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SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education and the Board of Regents of the University of Idaho for College and Universities, and the Office of the State Board of Education, the following amounts to be expended according to the designated programs and expense classes, from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017:

35 SECTION 2. NON-GENERAL FUND REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY. There is hereby 36 reappropriated to the State Board of Education and the Board of Regents of the University of Idaho for College and Universities any unexpended and unencumbered balances of moneys categorized as dedicated funds appropriated or reappropriated for fiscal year 2016, to be used for nonrecurring expenditures, for the period July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017.

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the Legislature that 5 6 of the amount appropriated in Section 1, Subsection V., of this act, the following amounts may be used as follows: (1) An amount not to exceed \$902,600 7 may be used by the Office of the State Board of Education for systemwide needs 8 that benefit all of the four-year institutions and promote accountability 9 10 and information transfer throughout the higher education system; and (2) An amount of approximately \$1,960,500 may be used for the mission and goals 11 of the Higher Education Research Council as outlined in State Board of Ed-12 ucation Policy III.W., which includes awards for infrastructure, matching 13 grants, and competitive grants through the Idaho Incubation Fund program. 14

SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the Legislature that 15 the president of the State Board of Education shall provide a written report 16 to the Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee, the Senate Education Commit-17 tee, and the House Education Committee on the implementation and effective-18 19 ness of the funding appropriated for the Complete College Idaho initiative. Reporting shall address the \$2,759,700 appropriated in fiscal year 2015, the 20 \$2,033,800 appropriated in fiscal year 2016, and the \$2,000,000 included in 21 Section 1 of this act. The board may use the measures of effectiveness sub-22 23 mitted by the institutions in their budget requests or develop other measures as necessary. Reporting to the Legislature should occur no later than 24 25 February 1, 2017.

SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the Legislature that the cybersecurity lab that will be funded through the appropriation to Boise State University in Section 1 of this act will include collaboration with the Idaho National Laboratory (INL) and that its assets will be available for further collaboration with the University of Idaho and Idaho State University by utilization of the Idaho Regional Optical Network (IRON), thereby taking advantage of computing resources at each institution and the INL.

SECTION 6. EXEMPTIONS FROM OBJECT AND PROGRAM TRANSFER LIMITATIONS. 33 For fiscal year 2017, the State Board of Education and the Board of Regents 34 of the University of Idaho for College and Universities is hereby exempted 35 from the provisions of Section 67-3511(1), (2) and (3), Idaho Code, allow-36 ing unlimited transfers between object codes and between programs, for all 37 moneys appropriated to it for the period July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017. 38 Legislative appropriations shall not be transferred from one fund to another 39 fund unless expressly approved by the Legislature. 40
