- 8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:
- 9 SECTION 1. That Section 34-433, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 10 amended to read as follows:
 - 34-433. MONTHLY CORRECTION OF ELECTION REGISTER FROM REPORTED DEATHS. The state board of health <u>and welfare</u> shall, on or about the <u>25th twenty-fifth</u> day of each month, furnish to the secretary of state a listing showing the name, age, county of residence and residence address of each Idaho resident who has died during the preceding month. <u>Such list shall be created and maintained as a nonexempt public record.</u> The secretary of state shall sort this list by county and furnish a copy of same to each county clerk. Each county clerk shall immediately cancel all registrations of individuals reported as deceased by the state board of health <u>and welfare</u> in the board's report to the secretary of state.
 - SECTION 2. That Section 34-434, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - 34-434. RETENTION OF NOTICES AND CORRESPONDENCE RELATING TO CORRECTION OF ELECTION REGISTERS. Copies of all notices and other correspondence issued pursuant to the directives contained in sections 67 and 68 of this act 34-432 and 34-433, Idaho Code, shall be retained by the county clerk for a period of two (2) years from the date of mailing. These notices and correspondence are nonexempt public records.
 - SECTION 3. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2022.
