4	VICES UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES AND TO PROVIDE THAT LICENSED DENTISTS
5	ARE NOT PROHIBITED FROM SUPERVISING CERTAIN DENTAL HEALTH AIDE THERA-
5	PISTS.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Section 54-930, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 54-930. EXCEPTIONS TO APPLICATION OF ACT. (1) This act shall not be construed as prohibiting a physician or surgeon, duly authorized to practice as such in this state, from treating diseases of the mouth or performing operations in oral surgery; nor as prohibiting persons authorized by the laws of another state, territory or country to practice dentistry or dental hygiene therein, or persons teaching in approved dental or dental hygiene schools, from making clinical demonstrations before meetings of dentists or dental hygienists in Idaho nor as prohibiting any person from performing merely mechanical work upon inert matter in a dental laboratory, nor to prohibit students in approved dental or dental hygiene schools from practicing dentistry or dental hygiene therein as part of their training or education.
- (2) Effective January 1, 2019, this act shall not be construed as prohibiting a dental health aide therapist from providing services in a facility operated by an Indian health program, as defined in 25 U.S.C. 1603(12), if the dental health aide therapist:
 - (a) Is certified by a community health aide certification board within the Indian health service under authority of 25 U.S.C. 1616 or by a tribe that has adopted standards no less stringent than those required under 25 U.S.C. 1616;
 - (b) Attended a regionally accredited institution accredited by the commission on dental accreditation and approved by the state board of dentistry; and
 - (c) Is acting under the indirect supervision of a licensed dentist.
- (3) Effective January 1, 2019, this act shall not be construed as prohibiting a licensed dentist from supervising a dental health aide therapist providing services described in subsection (2) of this section.
