Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho: 8

9 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Lieutenant Governor the following amounts to be expended according to the designated 10 expense classes from the General Fund for the period July 1, 2022, through 11 June 30, 2023: 12

SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519, Idaho Code, the Office of the Lieutenant Governor is authorized no more than three (3.00) full-time equivalent positions at any point during the period July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023, unless specifically authorized by the The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly of any increased positions so authorized.

SECTION 3. EXEMPTIONS FROM TRANSFER LIMITATIONS. The Office of the Lieutenant Governor is hereby exempted from the provisions of Section 67-3511(1) and (3), Idaho Code, allowing unlimited transfers between expense classes for all moneys appropriated to it for the period July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023. Legislative appropriations shall not be transferred from one fund to another fund unless expressly approved by the Legislature.

SECTION 4. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2022.
