STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING A CERTAIN PENDING RULE DOCKET OF THE IDAHO DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME RELATING TO RULES GOVERNING THE TAKING OF GAME BIRDS IN THE STATE OF IDAHO.

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with legislative intent; and

WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that a certain pending rule docket of the Idaho Department of Fish and Game relating to Rules Governing the Taking of Game Birds in the State of Idaho is not consistent with legislative intent and should be rejected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the First Regular Session of the Sixty-first Idaho Legislature, the House of Representatives and the Senate concurring therein, that IDAPA 13.01.09, Idaho Department of Fish and Game Rules Governing the Taking of Game Birds in the State of Idaho, adopted as a pending rule under Docket Number 13-0109-1001, the entire rule-making docket, be, and the same is hereby rejected and declared null, void and of no force and effect.
