2 STATING LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS AND APPROVING FEE RULES OF THE DIVISION OF
3 OCCUPATIONAL AND PROFESSIONAL LICENSES REVIEWED BY THE HOUSE BUSINESS
4 COMMITTEE AND THE SENATE COMMERCE AND HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE WITH
5 EXCEPTIONS.

6 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 WHEREAS, the Legislature pursuant to Section 67-5224, Idaho Code, must
8 approve certain administrative rules that impose a fee or charge by adoption
9 of a concurrent resolution before the rules become effective; and

10 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive
11 agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the
12 event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with leg-
13 islative intent; and

14 WHEREAS, the House Business Committee and the Senate Commerce and Human
15 Resources Committee reviewed rules that impose a fee or charge adopted by the
16 Division of Occupational and Professional Licenses; and

17 WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that rules of the Divi-
18 sion of Occupational and Professional Licenses, Rules of the Idaho Electri-
19 cal Board, are not consistent with legislative intent; and

20 WHEREAS, the Legislature finds that it is in the public interest to
21 adopt this resolution.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the First Regular Ses-
23 sion of the Sixty-seventh Idaho Legislature, the House of Representatives
24 and the Senate concurring therein, that pending fee rules adopted by the Di-
25 vision of Occupational and Professional Licenses, pursuant to the Adminis-
26 trative Procedure Act and submitted through the Office of the Administrative
27 Rules Coordinator to the Legislature for review during the 2023 legislative
28 session and reviewed by the House Business Committee and the Senate Commerce
29 and Human Resources Committee, be, and the same are hereby approved, with the
30 exception of the following enumerated pending fee rule.

31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Division of Occupational and Professional
32 Licenses, Rules of the Idaho Electrical Board, IDAPA 24.39.10, Docket
33 No. 24-3910-2201, Section 100., Subsection 05.; Section 200., Subsection
34 03.c.; Section 200., Subsection 03.c.i.; and Section 600., only, are hereby
35 rejected and not approved, and thereby pursuant to Sections 67-5291 and
36 67-5224, Idaho Code, are declared null, void, and of no force and effect.
