- STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING A CERTAIN RULE OF THE DE PARTMENT OF HEALTH AND WELFARE RELATING TO CRIMINAL HISTORY AND BACK GROUND CHECKS.
- 5 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive 7 agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the 8 event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with leg-9 islative intent; and

10 WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that a certain rule of the 11 Department of Health and Welfare relating to Criminal History and Background 12 Checks is not consistent with legislative intent and should be rejected.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the First Regular Ses-14 sion of the Sixty-first Idaho Legislature, the House of Representatives and the Senate concurring therein, that IDAPA 16.05.06, Department of Health 15 and Welfare Rules Governing Criminal History and Background Checks, Section 16 210, Disgualifying Crimes Resulting in an Unconditional Denial, Subsection 17 01.j relating to Disqualifying Crimes, only, adopted as a pending rule under 18 Docket Number 16-0506-1001, be, and the same is hereby rejected and declared 19 null, void and of no force and effect. 20
