2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING A CERTAIN RULE OF THE DI-
3 VISION OF VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION RELATING TO RULES AND MINIMUM STAN-
4 DARDS GOVERNING EXTENDED EMPLOYMENT SERVICES.

5 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive
7 agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the
8 event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with leg-
9 islative intent; and

10 WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that certain rules of the
11 Division of Vocational Rehabilitation relating to Rules and Minimum Stan-
12 dards Governing Extended Employment Services are not consistent with leg-
13 islative intent and should be rejected.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the First Regular Ses-
15 sion of the Sixty-fifth Idaho Legislature, the House of Representatives
16 and the Senate concurring therein, that IDAPA 47.01.02, Rules Governing
17 Rules and Minimum Standards Governing Extended Employment Services, Sec-
18 tion 500., Subsection 03.c., adopted as a pending rule under Docket Number
19 47-0102-1801, only, be, and the same is hereby rejected and declared null,
20 void, and of no force and effect.
