2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING A CERTAIN RULE OF THE DI-
3 VISION OF BUILDING SAFETY RELATING TO RULES CONCERNING UNIFORM PLUMBING
4 CODE.

5 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive
7 agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the
8 event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with leg-
9 islative intent; and

10 WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that a certain rule of the
11 Division of Building Safety relating to Rules Concerning Uniform Plumbing
12 Code is not consistent with legislative intent and should be rejected.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the First Regular Ses-
14 sion of the Sixty-second Idaho Legislature, the House of Representatives and
15 the Senate concurring therein, that IDAPA 07.02.06, Division of Building
16 Safety, Rules Concerning Uniform Plumbing Code, Section 011, Subsection 09,
17 only, adopted as a pending rule under Docket Number 07-0206-1201, be, and the
18 same is hereby rejected and declared null, void and of no force and effect.
