HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 27

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

STATING LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS AND REQUESTING THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO CONVENE A TASK FORCE REGARDING THE DESIRABILITY OF COMBINING THE DIVISION OF VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION AND THE COMMISSION FOR THE BLIND AND VISUALLY IMPAIRED.

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

WHEREAS, in an effort to eliminate duplication and to increase service delivery to clients, in 2002, the Governor's Blue Ribbon Task Force recommended reorganizing the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation and the Office of the State Board of Education into one administrative unit with separate budgetary divisions reporting to the Executive Director of the Office of the State Board of Education; and

WHEREAS, currently the Administrator of the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation reports to the Executive Director of the Office of the State Board of Education but receives separate budgetary appropriations, which limits their ability to share administrative resources; and

WHEREAS, there has been interest in the past of merging the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation and the Commission for the Blind and Visually Impaired to save on the costs of functions such as information technology and fiscal and management positions; and

WHEREAS, it would be valuable to evaluate cost data from other states that once had separate agencies for vocational rehabilitation and the blind and visually impaired, then combined them to present a solid pre and post comparison; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature believes it would be valuable to have the State Board of Education convene a task force to gauge the feasibility of combining the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation and the Commission for the Blind and Visually Impaired.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the First Regular Session of the Sixty-first Idaho Legislature, the House of Representatives and the Senate concurring therein, that the State Board of Education is requested to convene a task force to gauge the feasibility and identify the pros and cons of combining the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation and the Commission for the Blind and Visually Impaired, including impacts on services, both positive and negative as well as a governance model.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force should identify opportunities to increase efficiencies, streamline federal reporting processes, decrease duplication and enhance coordination for the overall benefit of each agency's clients and that membership of the task force shall include Coalitions of Advocates for the Disabled, the Vocational Rehabilitation Council, the Commission for the Blind and Visually Impaired and the Developmental Disability Council, with the State Board of Education appointing

all members and the chair of the task force except that the Commission for the Blind and Visually Impaired shall appoint two members.

 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the administrators of the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation and the Commission for the Blind and Visually Impaired, the Division of Financial Management and the Budget and Policy Analysis Division of the Legislative Services Office shall be ex officio nonvoting members of the task force.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall report its findings and recommendations to the Second Regular Session of the Sixty-first Idaho Legislature, to the Division of Financial Management and the Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee.
