1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND APPROVING PENDING RULES OF THE DE-
3 PARTMENT OF JUVENILE CORRECTIONS, THE IDAHO STATE POLICE, THE COMMIS-
4 SION OF PARDONS AND PAROLE, AND THE OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS
5 REVIEWED BY THE HOUSE JUDICIARY, RULES AND ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE AND
6 THE SENATE JUDICIARY AND RULES COMMITTEE.

7 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

8 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, the Legislature must
9 approve pending administrative rules by adoption of a concurrent resolu-
10 tion; and

11 WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, any
12 pending rule that is not approved by adoption of a concurrent resolution
13 shall expire upon adjournment sine die of the legislative session during
14 which the agency submits the pending rule to the Legislature for review; and

15 WHEREAS, the House Judiciary, Rules and Administration Committee and
16 the Senate Judiciary and Rules Committee reviewed pending rules adopted by
17 the Department of Juvenile Corrections, the Idaho State Police, the Commis-
18 sion of Pardons and Parole, and the Office of Administrative Hearings; and

19 WHEREAS, the Legislature finds that it is in the public interest to
20 adopt this resolution.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular Ses-
22 sion of the Sixty-seventh Idaho Legislature, the House of Representatives
23 and the Senate concurring therein, that the following pending rules adopted
24 by the Department of Juvenile Corrections, pursuant to the Administrative
25 Procedure Act and submitted through the Office of the Administrative Rules
26 Coordinator to the Legislature for review during the 2024 legislative ses-
27 sion and reviewed by the House Judiciary, Rules and Administration Committee
28 and the Senate Judiciary and Rules Committee, be, and the same are hereby ap-
29 proved:

30 (1) 05.01.02, Rules and Standards for Secure Juvenile Detention Cen-
31 ters, Docket No. 05-0102-2301; and

32 (2) 05.01.04, Uniform Standards for Juvenile Probation Services,
33 Docket No. 05-0104-2301.

34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pending rules adopted by the Idaho State Po-
35 lice, the Commission of Pardons and Parole, and the Office of Administra-
36 tive Hearings, pursuant to the Administrative Procedure Act and submitted
37 through the Office of the Administrative Rules Coordinator to the Legisla-
38 ture for review during the 2024 legislative session and reviewed by the House
39 Judiciary, Rules and Administration Committee and the Senate Judiciary and
40 Rules Committee, be, and the same are hereby approved.
