1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND APPROVING THE RECESS OF THE SECOND
3 REGULAR SESSION OF THE SIXTY-SEVENTH IDAHO LEGISLATURE APRIL 4 THROUGH
4 APRIL 9, 2024, RECONVENING ON APRIL 10, 2024, AND PROVIDING THAT NO UN-
5 VOUCHERED OR VOUCHERED EXPENSE ALLOWANCE SHALL BE PAYABLE TO ANY MEM-
6 BER OF THE LEGISLATURE FOR THE TIME PERIOD DURING SUCH TEMPORARY RECESS
7 WITHOUT THE APPROVAL OF THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OR
8 THE PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF THE SENATE.

9 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

10 WHEREAS, the Second Regular Session of the Sixty-seventh Idaho Legisla-
11 ture convened on January 8, 2024, and continues in session as of the date of
12 introduction of this concurrent resolution; and

13 WHEREAS, the members of the Second Regular Session of the Sixty-seventh
14 Idaho Legislature desire to recess April 4 through April 9, 2024, reconven-
15 ing on April 10, 2024; and

16 WHEREAS, the report of the Citizens' Committee on Legislative Compensa-
17 tion provides that, if the Legislature, by passage of a concurrent resolu-
18 tion, adjourns to a day certain for more than three days, no unvouchered or
19 vouchered expense allowance shall be payable to any member of the Legisla-
20 ture for the time period during such temporary recess without the approval of
21 the Speaker of the House of Representatives or the President Pro Tempore of
22 the Senate.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular Ses-
24 sion of the Sixty-seventh Idaho Legislature, the House of Representatives
25 and the Senate concurring therein, that the Second Regular Session of the
26 Sixty-seventh Idaho Legislature shall recess April 4 through April 9, 2024,
27 reconvening on April 10, 2024.

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no unvouchered or vouchered expense al-
29 lowance shall be payable to any member of the Legislature for the time period
30 during such temporary recess without the approval of the Speaker of the House
31 of Representatives or the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.
